Global Leadership Academy Celebrates the Outstanding Achievements of the Class of 2024

With a 100% matric pass rate and an extraordinary 97% Bachelor's Pass Rate – the highest in the school's history – 72 out of 74 learners are now eligible to pursue university studies. Collectively, the class achieved an impressive 116 distinctions, averaging 1.57 distinctions per learner.

The outstanding performance of this group is reflected across all subjects, with notable averages including Visual Arts at 83%, Dramatic Arts and Information Technology at 79%, Accounting at 77%, Life Orientation at 76%, Mathematical Literacy and Engineering Graphics and Design at 75%, Tourism at 73%, and Afrikaans and English First Additional Languages at 72%. The overall school average of 68% highlights the consistent effort and commitment of this exceptional class.
